STUDENTS WILL BE EVALUATED BASED ON FOLLOWING THE CRITERIA

- 1. CREATION OF A PORTFOLIO WHICH MUST INCLUDE:
- A cover page of the student's personal information: Name, Age, School and reason(s) why the student is interested in joining the Japanese club, Contact information such as an email address. THE STUDENTMUST INSERT AN APPROPRIATE PHOTO OF HIM/ HERSELF
- Completion of all the course work exercises found at the end of each lesson from 1-6.
- Choose one aspect of Japanese culture such as cuisine, floral arrangement, manga/ anime ,traditional dress, martial arts, etc, a known area such as Tokyo, Kyoto, Kobe , Hiroshima, etc or a place of interest in Japan like Himeji castle and write a short paragraph between 80-100 words.
- 2. Written exam: Situations & Multiple Choice
- 3. Oral exam: Carry out role play with a partner on one of the relevant topics taught.
