

**THE IMPERFECT SUBJUNCTIVE** is also used with conditional clauses.

Si fuera rico/a , compraría un coche. – If I were rich, I would buy a car.

Rules when using this structure

If the condition is more doubtful , the “if” clause will be in the imperfect subjunctive with the second clause in the conditional tense. For example:

If I were to go to Spain, I would learn more Spanish. – Si fuera a España , aprendería más español.

If I were to win the lottery, I would buy a plane. – (Si me tocara la lotería/ Si ganara la lotería, compraría un avión.

Using the impersonal verbs to create rules

(No se puede – One/ You cannot)/ ( No se debe- One /You must not)/ ( Se prohíbe – It is forbidden)

- hablar en clase mientras habla (el professor / la profesora) – (to) talk in class while the teacher is talking
- comer en clase –( to) eat in class
- fumar – (to) smoke
- llevar joyas- (to) wear jewellery
- usar los teléfonos móviles- (to) use cell phones
- masticar chicle- (to) chew gum
- arrojar objetos – (to) throw objects

Se debe ... (One must ...)

- llevar uniforme – (to ) wear a uniform
- respetar (a la profesora / al professor) – (to ) respect the teacher
- ser puntual todos los días – (to) be punctual every day
