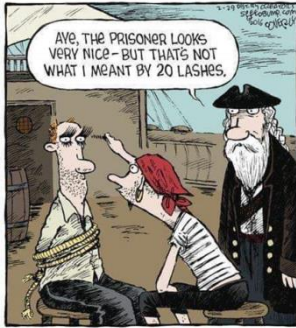


### Explaining English using jokes
