

Immediate Future

Qu'est- ce que tu vas faire ce week-end? - What are you going to do this week end ?

You can use 'aller' + the infinitive - to talk about the future

Aller- to go

Je vais- I am going

Tu vas- You (sing.) are going

Il/ elle va - He / she is going

Nous allons- We are going

Vous allez - You (pl.) are going

Ils/ elles vont - They are going



SENTENCE CONSTRUCTION:

Je vais écouter de la musique. I am going to listen to music.



(Aller : conjugated, whereas the second verb : écouter remains in the infinitive/ not conjugated)

LEISURE ACTIVITIES

2. Écouter (de la musique/ la radio)- to listen (to music / to the radio)

8. Jouer aux cartes- to play cards /Jouer du piano- to play the piano
9. Préparer le diner- to prepare dinner
10. Faire les magasins/ faire du shopping- to shop / to go shopping
